# Q. What is the maximum number of people that can attend?

A. Up to 65 guests inside the castle and up to 30 guests in the Glass House or the Garden Museum.

#### Q. What are the ceremony times?

A. Please see above.

# Q. Can you arrange the Registrar?

A. The arrangement of the Celebrant and the Marriage Ceremony itself is the responsibility of the couple to be married. For further information, please contact the local Registrar.

#### Q. Can you have a wedding in the castle gardens?

A. Yes and should the weather be unfavourable, we can provide cover in the Gardens Museum or Victorian Glass House which are licenced to accommodate 30 guests.

#### Q. What is the closing time for the venue? Is it possible to have a late licence?

A. Closing time for the venue is 11.00pm. A late license is not available.

# Q. Do you provide a drinks bar?

A. There is no bar facility available, but we do offer a selection of Champagnes and Fine Wines. Spirits and other beverages can be supplied on request.

#### Q. Do you provide accommodation in the castle?

A. No due to the fact that it is still a family home, however we do have three charming self-catering estate cottages which are available to wedding parties at a discounted rate. See the Hospitality section of our website for further information.

### Q. How do I arrange flowers, music, taxis and other services?

A. Our experienced staff will be on hand to assist you with your arrangements.

#### Q. What photographic locations are available at Dunvegan Castle?

A. Al areas of the Dunvegan Castle & Gardens are available for you with the exception of the castle's private apartments.

## Q. What deposit will I pay?

A. An £800.00 deposit will be taken at the time of your wedding booking.



# **TERMS & CONDITIONS**

- 1. Provisional reservations will be held for a maximum of 14 days.
- 2. Wedding reservations will be confirmed on receipt of the £800.00 deposit payment, a signed booking form and these terms and conditions.
- 3. Final confirmation of the wedding party numbers are required no later than 60 days prior to the wedding.
- 4. The balance will be payable no later than 30 days prior to the wedding.
- 5. Final account for any additional requirements made on the day are payable within 7 days after the event.
- 6. The organiser is liable for the actions of their guests and for any damage caused to the building, fixtures and fittings.
- 7. We reserve the right to alter or amend the facilities we offer.
- 8. Cancellation Fee. We recommend that you take an insurance policy to cover you in the event of a cancellation.
  - Up to five months before the date booked deposit will not be refunded.
  - 3-5 months -50% of total estimated bill based on the numbers advised in the booking confirmation.
  - 0-3 months -100% of total estimated bill based on contracted numbers.
