### **TERMS & CONDITIONS**

- 1. Provisional reservations will be held for a maximum of 14 days.
- 2. Wedding reservations will be confirmed upon receipt of the £1,500.00 deposit payment and a signed booking form.
- 3. Final confirmation of the wedding party numbers is required no later than 60 days prior to the wedding.
- 4. The balance will be due no later than 30 days prior to the wedding.
- 5. Final account for any additional requirements made on the day are payable within 7 days after the event.
- 6. The organiser is liable for the actions of their guests and for any damage caused to the building, fixtures and fittings.
- 7. We reserve the right to alter and/or amend the facilities we offer.
- 8. Cancellation Fee. We recommend that you take an insurance policy to cover you in the event of a cancellation.
  - a. Up to five months before the date booked, the deposit will not be refunded.
  - b. 3-5 months -50% of total estimated bill based on the numbers advised in the booking confirmation.
  - c. 0-3 months -100% of total estimated bill based on contracted numbers.
